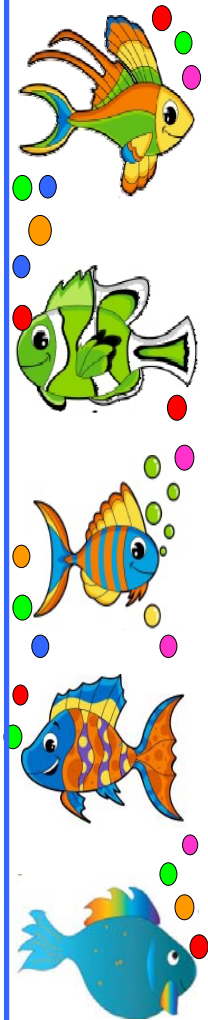


Lougheed Area's Fishing for Ideas
